

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN OR VETERINARIAN

Contains the nerve poison Bromethalin. This is not an anticoagulant type rodenticide. For humans or animals ingesting bait and/or showing poisoning signs (such as muscle tremors, loss of hind limb use, or seizures for animals), limit absorption by either emesis or gastric lavage. Sub lethal symptoms, if present, would be the result of cerebral edema and should be treated accordingly through administration of an osmotic diuretic and conticosteroid.

HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS
CAUTION: Harmful if swellowed or absorbed through the skin. Causes modetate eye irritation. Keep away from children, domestic animals, and pets. Do not get in eyes, on skin, or on-clothing. All handlers (including applicators) must wear long-sleeved shirt and barrier laminate gloves. ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

This product is extremely toxic to mammals and birds. Dogs and scavenging mammals and birds might be poisoned if they feed upon animals that have eaten this bait. Do not apply directly to water, or to areas where surface water is present or to intertidal areas below the mean high water mark. Runoff may also be hazardous to aquatic organisms in water adjacent to treated areas. Do not contaminate water when disposing of equipment wash water or rinsate.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

IT IS A VIOLATION OF FEDERAL LAW TO USE THIS PRODUCT IN A MANNER INCONSISTENT WITH ITS LABELING.

READ THIS LABEL: Read this entire label and follow all use directions and use precautions. Use only for the sites, pests, and application methods described on this label.

IMPORTANT: Do not expose children, pets or other non-target animals to rodenticides. To help prevent accidents:

- 1. Store product not in use in a location out of reach of children and pets.
- 2. Apply bait in locations out of reach of children, pets, domestic animals and non-target wildlife, or in tamper-resistant bait stations. These stations must be resistant to destruction by dogs and by children under six years of age, and must be used in a manner that prevents such children from reaching into bait compartments and obtaining bait. If bait can be shaken from stations when they are lifted, units must be secured or otherwise immobilized. Even stronger bait stations are needed in areas open to hoofed livestock, raccoons, bears, or other potentially destructive animals, or in areas prone to vandalism.
- 3. Dispose of product container, and unused, spoiled, and unconsumed bait as specified on this label Bait stations are mandatory for outdoor, above-ground use. Tamper-resistant bait stations must be used if children, pets, non-target mammals, or birds may access the bait.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE (CONTINUED)

USE RESTRICTIONS: This product may only be used to control the following rodent pests in and around man-made structures: House mouse (Mus musculus), Norway rat (Rattus norvegicus), Roof rat (Rattus rattus), Cotton rats (Sigmodon hispidus), Eastern harvest mouse (Reithrodontomys humuli), Golden mouse (Ochrotomys nuttalli), Polynesian rat (Rattus exulans), and Meadow vole (Microtus pennsylvanicus). This product must be used in and within 100 feet of man-made structures constructed in a manner so as to be vulnerable to commensal rodent invasions and/or to harboring or attracting rodent infestations. Examples of such structures include homes and other permanent or temporary residences, food processing facilities, industrial and commercial buildings, trash receptacles, agricultural and public buildings, transport vehicles, (ships, trains, aireraft), docks and port or terminal buildings and related structures around and associated with these sites. Fence and perintere bailing, beyond 100 feet from a structure as defined above, is prohibited. This product must not be applied directly to food or feed crops. Burrow baiting with TOP GUN™ All-Weather Rodenticide Bait Block® is prohibited.

Do not sell this product in individual containers holding less than four (4) pounds of bait

SELECTION OF TREATMENT AREAS: Determine areas where rats or house mice will most likely find and consume the bait. Generally, these areas are along walls, by gnawed openings, in or beside burrows, in corners and concealed places, between floors and walls, or in locations where rodents or their signs have been seen. Protect bait from rain or snow. Remove as a much alternative food as possible. APPLICATION DIRECTIONS RATS. Apply 2 to 12 TOP GUNI™ All-Weather Rodentiade Bait Blocks@. Space placements at intervals of 15 to 30 feet in infested areas. Maintain an uninterrupted supply of fresh bait for at least 10 days or until there no longer are signs of new feeding by rats.

MICE: Apply 1 to 2 TOP GUN™ All-Weather Rodenticide Bait Blocks® at each placement location.

Space placements at 8- to 12-foot intervals. Larger placements (up to 2 ounces) may be needed at points of very high house mouse activity. Maintain an uninterrupted supply of fresh bait for at least 15 days or until there are no longer signs of new feeding by house mice.

FOLLOW-UP: Adjust the amount of bait applied to the level of rat and mouse feeding expected at each bait placement location. Highest bait consumption is expected to occur on the first day or two after treatment. After several days, inspect bait placements and replenish bait at sites where there is heavy feeding or where there is continued evidence of rat and mouse activity. Maintain bait for at least one week and continue baiting until all signs of rat and mouse activity have ceased or it becomes clear that the remaining rats and mice are not attracted to the

Wearing barrier laminate gloves, collect and properly dispose of all dead rats and mice and leftover bait. To discourage reinfestation, limit sources of rat and mouse food, water, and harborage as much as possible. If reinfestation does occur, repeat treatment. Where a continuous source of infestation is present, establish permanent bait stations and replenish as needed.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

Pesticide Storage: Store in original container in a cool, dry place inaccessible to children and pets. Keep containers closed and away from other chemicals.

Pesticide Disposal: Dispose of wastes resulting from the use of this product in trash or at an approved waste

Container Handling: Nonrefillable container. Do not reuse or refill this container. Triple rinse (or equivalent) then offer for recycling or reconditioning: or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill; or incineration.
